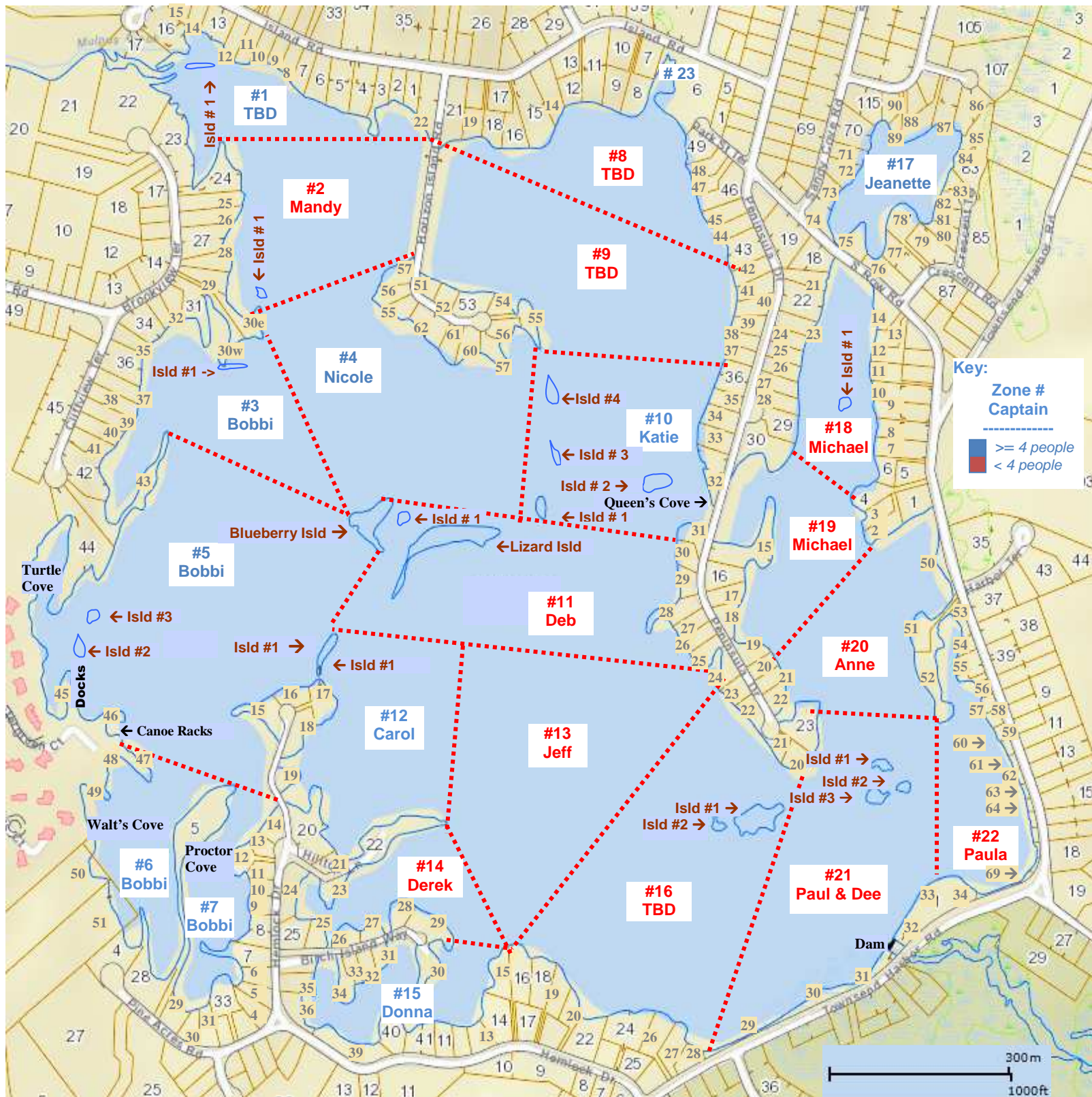
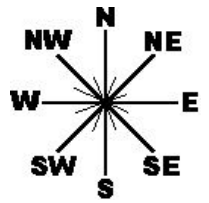


# FANWORT ZONE MAP

# Thanks For Volunteering!

Here's some helpful tips to make your Fanwort surveying easier:

**TEAM GOAL** – Each zone's goal is to fanwort survey once per week (preferably on a sunny, clear, calm day). Mornings or late afternoon seem to work best to view it. Wearing polarized glasses also makes it easier.

**TEAM CAPTAINS** - Team captains answer any questions, help to get you markers and create a team schedule to follow. If you haven't received a survey schedule or markers for your zone, email your captain or [fanwort@hickoryhillslake.com](mailto:fanwort@hickoryhillslake.com).

Some zones may be looking for a Captain (see map). If you're interested, please let us know!

**MARKERS** – Surveyors use “ H “ shaped orange plastic markers to mark each grouping of plant(s) in the lake. Simply release the weight from the marker and drop it into the water. The string will unravel for you on it's own, and stop when the weight hits the lake bottom. Once the DASH team removes the plant, the Orange marker will be replaced with a Yellow “ H “ marker for verification by your team. Please return Yellow markers to your Captain or the Office. We need them for next year!



**COMMUNICATE LOCATION** - If you find Fanwort or even if you're not sure but think it's a possibility, please drop a marker about 5 feet in front of the plant (**shore, plant, marker**), then send an email to: [fanwort@hickoryhillslake.com](mailto:fanwort@hickoryhillslake.com). Include the **Zone # and Property #** or **Zone # and Island #** it's closest to.

\*\*\* Report Like This → Zone #, Property #, short description (small/large, 10' off shore, etc), # of Plants, # of Markers \*\*\*



**GOOGLE MAP GPS LOCATION** – This of course is optional, but would be VERY HELPFUL. Taking your smart phone out of it's sealed plastic bag, OPEN GOOGLE MAPS and in the search field, at the top of the display, search for <http://hickoryhillslake.com/gps> bringing up the HHL Fanwort Map where you can now add a PIN identifying the Fanwort location you just marked. After adding the PIN, “SHARE” it via email to [fanwort@hickoryhillslake.com](mailto:fanwort@hickoryhillslake.com)

## How to Add PIN with your Smart Phone:

- 1) OPEN the GOOGLE MAPS APP
- 2) In the Search Field at the top of map, type in the link to the HHL Fanwort Google Map <http://hickoryhillslake.com/gps>
- 3) Zoom in on the map by “pinching out” until you can see your location clearly. **YOU MUST DO THIS IN THE GOOGLE MAPS APP** (not from a browser like IE, Chrome or Safari).
- 4) Press and hold the **BLUE DOT** that is marking your location. You'll notice a “**DROPPED PIN**” message gets created
- 5) select the words “**Dropped Pin**” that just appeared below the map
- 6) Select the words “**SHARE**”
- 7) Select your email account
- 8) The pre-populated email you just created already includes a link to your current GPS location, so just add the Zone #, Property # and how many plants its marking and send the email to [fanwort@hickoryhillslake.com](mailto:fanwort@hickoryhillslake.com) to report your sighting.

**This will be helpful to survey there again at a later time or early next season by divers!**

## Additional Tips:

It's helpful to have a marker ready to just toss close to the plant as you spot it. This helps you find it again as you float away a little and then you're able to slowly paddle back and adjust the marker in the proper spot (**5 feet in front of plant, i.e. shore – plant - marker**). Marker protects plant from passing boats.

The “ H “ Shaped markers sometimes need one manual flip after it's reached the bottom in order to sit flat on the water.
