




Hickory Hills 2012 Annual Boat Parade June 30th, Saturday at Noon From Island Road Beach

Fanwort Update

LMG members have been working hard on the fight to eradicate Fanwort from the Boat Cove. Last month a group of volunteers got together to



remove the Benthic Barriers from the bottom of the cove in preparation for the next big effort. The material gathered was dried and then removed completely


from Hickory Hills.

You'll notice this month at the cove, the use of machinery which is removing a layer of dirt from the cove and capturing the Fanwort. The goal is to remove the Fanwort entirely while continuing to run the drain pumps in order to keep the cove as dry as possible to identify possible new growth.

We REALLY need more VOLUNTEERS to help locate and mark the potential spread of this weed along the lake's shoreline. If you can help, please contact the office to be added to the weed watching schedule this season. THANK YOU!!

LANDFILL OPEN FOR YARD DEBRIS

Lunenburg's Landfill off Young's Road (behind Tri-Town Drive-In) will be open this season on consecutive Saturdays from **April 14th to May 19th 8am - 4pm**.



The accepted materials are grass clippings, bark mulch, wood chips, leaves, brush-diameter not to exceed three inches and some shrubbery & plantings, all containers must be removed.

No household trash, garbage or rubbish of any kind can remain at the landfill.

An Act protecting lakes and ponds from aquatic nuisances

The Massachusetts House and Senate have both engrossed a bill fining anyone who knowingly or intentionally places, or causes to be placed, an aquatic nuisance in or upon inland waters, or any vessel, boat transporter or any other equipment used in conjunction with such vessel or boat transporter, if the vessel, boat transporter or other equipment has growing thereon or attached thereto an aquatic nuisance, unless the vessel, boat transporter, truck-trailer transporter or other equipment used in connection therewith has been cleaned, decontaminated or treated to kill or remove the aquatic nuisance. Last week, the Senate accepted the House's amendment and the bill should be enacted shortly and sent to the Governor's desk for his signature.

The bill contains other important legislation regarding preventing aquatic nuisances. If you're interested in learning more, please contact the office.

Help Wanted: Youth Program Assistant


The Board of Directors would like to offer a part-time youth program again this summer. Each year we find this program to be a huge success and a welcomed event.




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Annual Shareholder Meeting Reminder

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Suction Harvester to Help Fight Fanwort

As most everyone is aware we are fighting the Fanwort invasive weed infestation in the boat ramp cove near Island Road. We are concerned that the weed has spread outside the containment area. In an effort to combat and help eradicate the weed the Board of Directors has commissioned the LMG to investigate suction harvesting. Suction harvesting is like a scaled down version of aqua mining. If anyone has seen the underwater diver mining for gold on the show Bering Sea Gold this is precisely the equipment we are investigating. It's an over grown underwater vacuum. Ours of course will not be on the scale of theirs but the concept is the same.

The team has visited a lake in New Hampshire that built their own suction harvester and determined that we too can build one. A pontoon boat was donated by Ashburnham Marine (**THANK YOU!!**) and that will act as the platform for the unit. So when you're out on the lake this summer and you see a large water vacuum please stop by and say hello to the operator. Don't be afraid to ask questions. Volunteers divers or operators are welcome. Please contact the office if you're interested in volunteering or learning more. ~ Tom Bertram

Please take a minute to read the cover letter enclosed; it will answer some of the more frequently asked questions. **Don't forget to update your email addresses and phone numbers.** We also ask you check to make sure we have all the details on your boats, who takes care of how they enter the lake and their serial numbers. Please make any changes on the form provided.

To obtain a car sticker which enables you to park in the resident only beach lots, please send a copy of your current vehicle registration. The stickers are free to residents in good standing. This is one of the few ways we have to insure only residents are using our lake facilities. Even if you had a car sticker before we cannot issue stickers without first seeing a copy of your current vehicle registration.

Landlords please ensure the office has current names and phone numbers for your tenants; please register any boats they may have; provide them with IDs; and give tenants a copy of the annual license you receive from the office. We appreciate all your help in keeping our records up to date.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation. Let's all have a safe and fun season!


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
